
#### KALEIDOSCOPE YOUTH CENTER

In 2023, 63% of Drop - in Center youth identified as **Nonbinary, Gender Non-Conforming, or Transgender.**

**Genderscope** is a vibrant affinity group at Kaleidoscope Youth Center, providing a safe and inclusive space for young adults aged 12-20 to explore and express their gender identity, engage in empowering workshops, and **connect** with peers **in a supportive community.** 





#### RACE/ETHNICITY

In 2023, **nearly 40%** of Drop - in Center youth identified as Black, Indigenous, or a person of color.

**QPOC** is a group for youth of color that provides resources, support, and community in a way that celebrates the multiple identities of LGBTQIA+ youth.

\*QPOC = Queer People of Color

#### **CENTER-BASED PROGRAMMING**

- 3652 visits to the Drop-In Center
- 7431 visits to all Center-Based programming
- 17: average age of Drop-In youth
- 607 unique youth
- 640 gender-supportive garments provided through GAP

#### **EDUCATION & OUTREACH**

- 4,444 professionals reached training and education
- 43 GSAs in network in the 2022-2023 school year
- 320 youth empowered through 24 GSA site visits
- 5 Bits and Bobs virtual mini-courses launched
- 88 virtual courses completed by community professionals

#### **BEHAVIORAL HEALTH**

- 322 individual therapeutic sessions provided, free of charge
- 40 community members trained in Question, Persuade, Refer
- 26 community wellness/support group sessions
- 3 graduate level **social work** students supported through **clinical internships**

#### COMMUNITY BASED WELLNESS

- 30 referred to **wraparound supportive services** (i.e. legal, housing, medical, financial)
- 9 provided Emergency Housing
- 7 newly housed through KYC housing (bringing the total to 19)
- 6 QPOC\* supported through scholarships
- 2nd Supportive Co-Housing Site opened
- Emergency Housing Program Manager hired to support community

#### ADVOCACY

- 600 individual pieces of testimony provided against HB 68
- 12 hours of in-person testimony provided against anti-LGBTQIA+ legislation
- 40 submissions from Franklin County candidates for November Voters Guide
- 6 Statehouse hearings had testimony provided by KYC staff

#### MISSION

KYC is informed by the practices of **restorative** and **transformational justice**, intersectionality, anti-oppression, racial justice, and **trauma informed and** healing engaged care.
